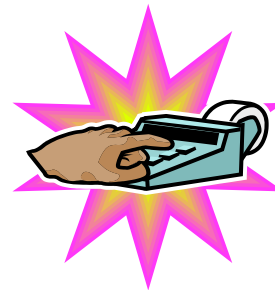
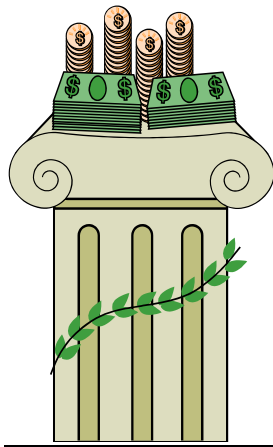
BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROGRAM

Emphasis is placed on the application of fundamentals, principles, and theories with the accounting equation approach. We study the theory of debits and credits, classification of accounts, construction and preparation of financial statements, use of trial balance, technical procedure involved in closing operating accounts and using workbook exercises and practice sets. The student is taught to record transactions in journals, post to ledgers, make trial balances, and prepare balance sheets and operating statements, and the adjusting and closing entries. These principles are studied as applied to the single proprietorship and partnership for organization, touching lightly on corporations.

SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS PROGRAM

Students participate every year in the Michigan Association of Certified Public Accountants High School Leadership Conference. This is an excellent opportunity to acquire information about the Accounting field, available jobs and information about the college programs available in Accounting. Whenever possible the class also participates in the Detroit Tiger Career Day at Comerica Park.
