### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROGRAM

Occupational Child Care at Riverview High School is designed to give the high school student a thorough understanding of childcare in a preschool setting. In Child Care, the high school student will take part in the set-up and daily operations of a state-licensed preschool classroom program. He/she will be responsible for the learning of a preschool age child on a daily basis. Other duties include but are not limited to: planning lessons, designing bulletin boards, designing and implementing arts and crafts projects, and preparing nutritious snacks for the children.



### SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS PROGRAM

The high school student will obtain CPR and First Aid training, as well as speech and Language training as it pertains to the 2½ - 5 year old child.

You will have the opportunity to:

*Teach Basic skills such as color, shape, number and letter recognition, personal hygiene, and social skills.*

*Establish and enforce rules for behavior and procedures for maintaining order.*

*Read books to the entire class or small groups.*

*Organize and lead activities designed to promote physical, mental, and social development, such as games, arts and crafts, music, and storytelling.*

*Identify children showing signs of emotional, developmental, or health-related problems, and discuss them with supervisors, parents or guardians, and child development specialists.*
