BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROGRAM

Family and Consumer Science offer the following courses: Child Development, Parenting, Nutritional Foods I, Nutritional Foods II, Personal Living and Family Living. Child Development covers the physical, social/emotional and intellectual development of children between birth and age 6. Students will also write a storybook for a young child. Parenting looks at issues pertaining to parental roles and responsibilities. Nutritional foods I covers the foundations of nutrition as well as the principles of cookery for grains, fruits, vegetables, dairy, and meats. Nutritional Foods II covers foreign foods and food related health problems. Personal Living addresses issues pertaining to being independent, money management, purchasing cars, renting apartments, credit and careers. Family living covers dating, marriage, and issues related to family life such as divorce, remarriage, alcohol and drug abuse, building a strong marriage, and money matters.
