BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROGRAM

Students are introduced to the industry standard in software applications in both the first and second year Graphics classes. Adobe SC5, the current industry standard is utilized to help prepare the program's students for success. Upon Graduation, whether entering the field of employment or continuing your education at the two or four-year College of university level, this class will be of value.

In the second year students are expected to increase proficiency in the various software applications they have utilized in class. Advanced techniques and project development are presented. Students are introduced to basic Web Design and Publishing, and animation techniques. Career and occupational opportunities are researched and resumes produced.

SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS PROGRAM

In this class students design and produce multi colored T-Shirts both by screen printing and one of the most current Printing methods, Dye-Sublimation. Other Dye-Sublimation projects include mugs, license plates, key chains, and mouse pads. Advanced projects include CD/DVD cover layout and design, website development and publishing, and introduction to Flash Animation.
