BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROGRAM

The first year provides an introduction to health careers. Students will learn anatomy and physiology, diseases and disorders, body systems, medical terminology and abbreviations. The course includes foundation standards, first aid, CPR, Infection Control, safety training Universal Precautions. Students are exposed to a wide variety of academic interactive health related activities preparing them for entry into the health care field.
